On 23.6.2017, at 13:00 a meeting of the GreenS – GPP Steering Committee was held at the headquarters of the Department of Environment in Nicosia.

Mrs. N. Georgiou-Tsiakalou welcomed the members of the committee and spoke about the purpose of the meeting, making a review of the CY GPP Awards of the previous years and the oncoming event for 2017.

A discussion followed about the revision and preparation of the 2017 tender announcement / invitation, and the cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture about the Ecolabel 25th anniversary. A possible date for the award ceremony set on 15th December 2017 (must be confirm with Central Cyprus Bank and the Ministry of Education and Culture).

New categories added for this year and new criteria have been added for the evaluation.

New categories are:

- Office IT equipment and household electric appliances (added oven and washing machines)
- Lighting was split to
 - Inside Lighting and
 - Street lighting (only for public sector)





- Tires
- Buildings (added Energy Performance of Buildings)
- Renewable Energy Sources
- Cleaning Products and Services
- Copying /Graphic Paper
- Food and Catering Services

Except of the new categories, CY GPP Awards 2017 were extended to private sector for the first time.

At the same time, members of the Commission were briefed on the GreenS training programs for GPP and the conclusions that came up from the three first training seminars that have been held. Also, the SC was informed about the progress of the GreenS project and the actions that were carried out about market research analysis. The results of the Market research will be discussed in the next meeting.

Ms Georgiou-Tsiakalou thanked the members of the Commission and noted that the documents (application forms and invitation) will be sent for comments before their publication.
