On 20.11.2017 at 10:00 p.m, the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the GreenS – GPP Steering Committee was held at the headquarters of the Department of Environment in Nicosia.

Mrs. N. Georgiou-Tsiakalou welcomed the committee members and referred to the purpose of the meeting, informing that 13 applications had been submitted. Eight (8) of them, from the public sector and five (5) of them from the private sector.

The purpose of the discussion was to examine the applications submitted by both the public and the private sector (for the first time) and their allocation and classification, but also to inform the members about the GPP market research results.

The committee decided to title the applications with symbols D 1 to D 8 (for public administration applications) and I-I5 (for private sector applications). An amendment of the scoreboard due to the new categories added for the year 2017 (Annex I).

After the evaluation of all applications and the rating of all the members of the SC, the final classification appears in the printed total score with the results (Annex II)

At the same time, information was provided to the members of the SC on the training programs that were carried out as well as the ones that will follow and concern the public/local Contracting Authorities. Also, the results of the Market analysis were discussed for products and services that fall under the provisions of the project.



The meeting was completed with a round table discussion and a light lunch.

Mrs. Georgiou-Tsiakalou informed the members of the Commission about the awarding of the CY GPP Awards 2017, on 15/12/2017 in the Amphitheatre of the Central Bank of Cyprus. The ceremony supported by the GreenS project (Horizon 2020) and the Central Bank of Cyprus.
