On 29 of May 2018, the last Roundtable meeting was organised together with the training session in Pafos.

Before the roundtable session, a complete introduction on the GPP field was presented to the participants:

- Introduction to GreenS and the results of the programme
- Introduction to GPP; what is GPP, main barriers and advantages, what is the status in Europe and in Cyprus
- GPP implementation in Cyprus
- Introduction to the Legal framework

Also, the specific energy categories of products were presented under the training session:

- Indoor and outdoor lighting. GPP criteria, good practices, exercise and discussion
- Office equipment IT and imaging. GPP criteria, good practices, exercise and discussion
- Vehicles. GPP criteria, good practices, exercise and discussion
- Heating and Cooling. GPP criteria, good practices, exercise and discussion
- Management of Green space. GPP criteria

The participants took the full picture of the GPP situation in Cyprus and the respective legislation.

The main topics of the roundtable discussion was the procedures and GPP support, led technology, experience and capacity of municipalities and communities to procure GPP, other barriers to implement successfully a street lighting GPP in the local authorities of Pafos. The local authorities have huge interest to upgrade the street lighting, especially after the announced street lighting GPP by the capital of Cyprus, Nicosia.
